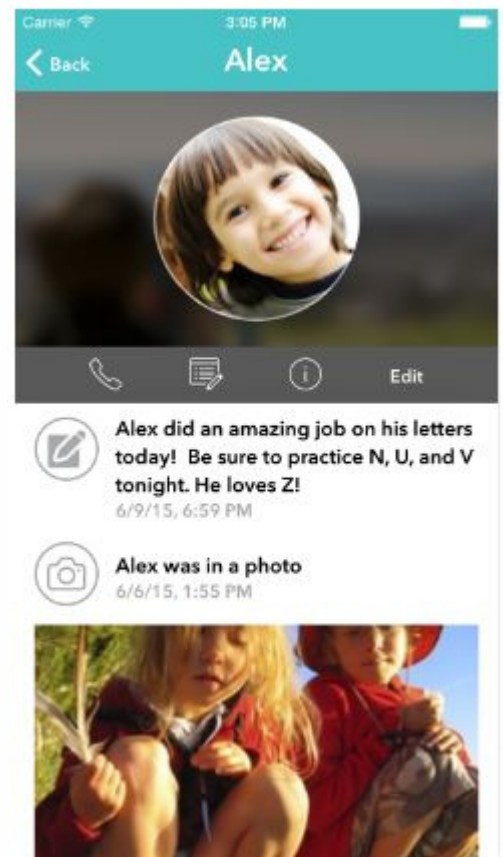

Discounts are not applied toward enrollment fees or any additional fees.

Discounts are applied to tuition only.

Tuition in Full

- 10% off for tuition in full at the start of the school year

Siblings With Same Address

- 10% off for second student (sibling) enrolling

Educator

- 10% off for current educators (same address as student)
- Current ID/copy of most recent pay stub on file

Active Duty: Military/Fire/Police/EMS

- 10% off for active duty families (same address as student)
- Current ID/copy of most recent pay stub on file

Current Restrictions

- No toys from home
- Lowered class ratios
- Extra change of clothes for all students
